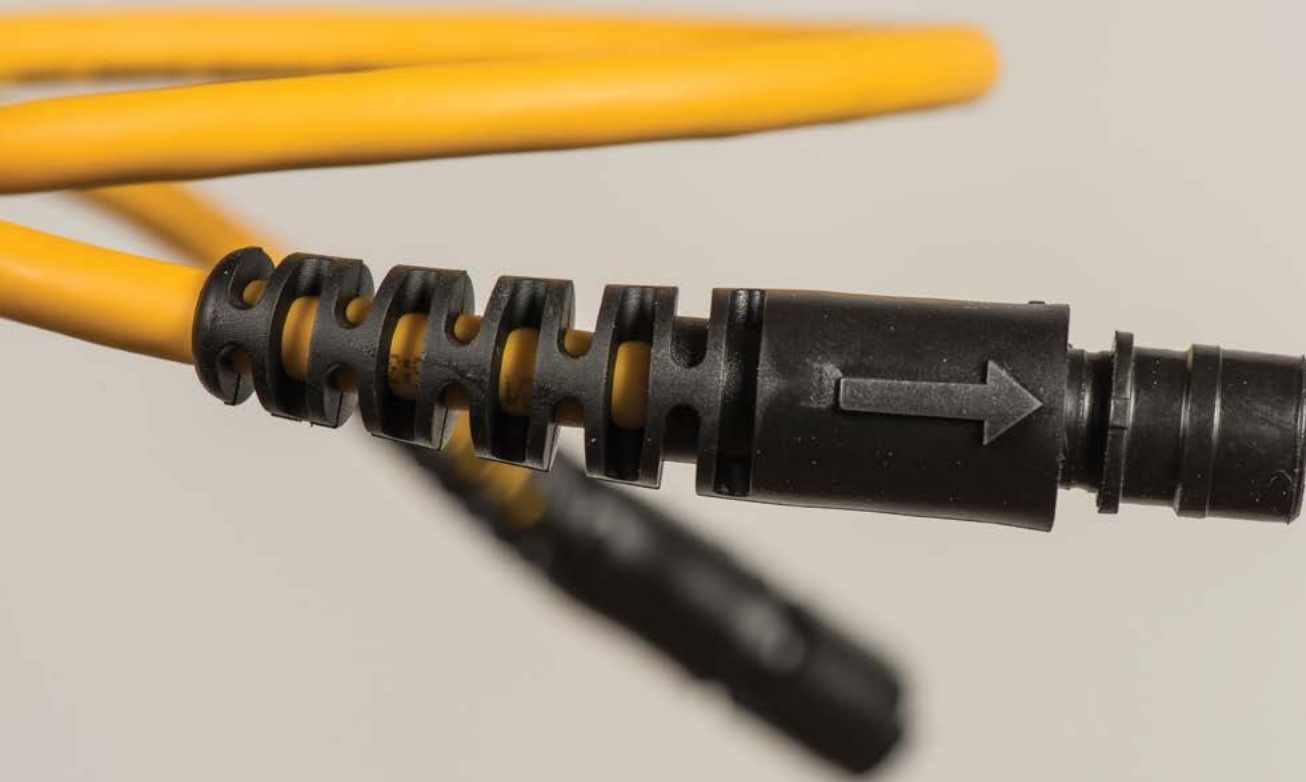

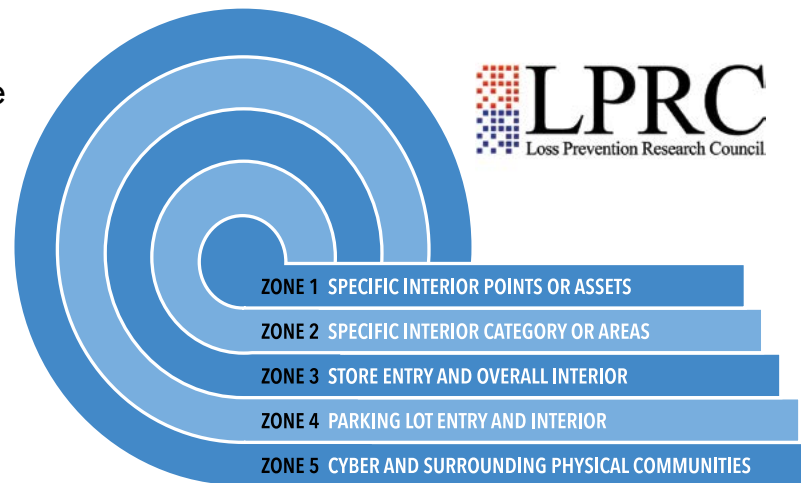


LPRC Zones of Influence - Zone 4
